WHERE CAN I CAMP?

There are many secluded spots to camp on Yorke Peninsula, with 19 sites designated as campgrounds by Yorke Peninsula Council. A permit per vehicle is required to camp at these places, with the permit transferable between all 19 campgrounds. The permit is per vehicle and costs \$10 per night, \$50 per week (5-7 nights), \$150 per month (28 nights), or \$500 per year, with generous discounts for local rate payers. This permit does NOT cover Innes National Park.

Following is a list of the various camping sites available

- 1. The Gap:** 34°14'06.5"S / 137°30'06.6"E
 Located on the north west coast of the peninsula, 15 kilometres north of Balgowan - access from Spencer Highway just south of Weetulta or along coastal track from Balgowan - beach launching - BYO water and firewood – toilet facilities available - gas/fuel stoves preferred – good beach for kids – beach fishing for tommies and gar – no shade
- 2. The Bamboos:** 34°15'10.0"S / 137°30'12.7"E
 Located on the north west coast of the peninsula, 12 kilometres north of Balgowan - access via coastal track from Balgowan - beach launch - BYO water and firewood - gas/fuel stoves preferred - patchy mobile phone reception - no shade – access not suitable for larger caravans and motorhomes - access track can get overgrown and sandy – no facilities
- 3. Tiparra Rocks:** 34°15'50.4"S / 137°30'05.1"E
 Located on the north west coast of the Yorke Peninsula, 8 kilometres north of Balgowan - access via coastal track from Balgowan - good snorkelling - BYO water and firewood - gas/fuel stoves preferred – no shade – access not suitable for larger caravans and motorhomes - access track can get overgrown and sandy
