

Here are the results of the recent survey:

Results from Monkey Survey online, we had 70 people to reply to this and those that returned survey forms we had 30 people. Not all questions were answered on some surveys but a good understanding of what the town people of Balgowan would like. I sent out 265 forms to every address in Balgowan so a 100 replies is a good return.

1. Most people have a house here for their and families use. There are only a few that are rental that we are aware of.
2. Most people spend at least 4 to 10 weeks in Balgowan on leisure time.
3. We have a younger generation coming on between 36 to 55 age brackets.
4. We all would like to see the phone system upgraded, and our general store to stock papers, bread, milk, ice creams and fuel.
5. Majority of people come to Balgowan for the relaxed quiet lifestyle then fishing, and followed closely by the good beaches.

The BPA continue to work with council to improve our boat ramp, I do believe that the phone system may be improved late July but won't hold my breath for this. As you will see the shade has gone up over children's playground and we hope to look at stage 2 later in year as finances are available or we are able to acquire grants that come available. The sign into Balgowan is having a face lift and should go up shortly.
